



**Prof. Jong-Yil Chai**

Prof. Dr. Jong-Yil Chai graduated from Seoul National University College of Medicine (M. D.) in 1976 and obtained Ph.D. in 1984 majoring medical parasitology at the same university. He is now Emeritus Professor at the Department of Parasitology and Tropical Medicine, Seoul, Korea since 2016 and the President of Korea Association of Health Promotion since 2016. He has been investigating the diseases caused by intestinal parasites, in particular intestinal flukes (heterophyids, echinostomes, neodiplostomes, and gymnophallids), roundworms, and protozoans for over 40 years in Korea. He has also been working in other Asian countries, including China, Lao PDR, Cambodia, Vietnam, Myanmar, and Tanzania. He published 10 books and more than 530 original research papers on parasitology. He has been serving as the Editor of The Korean Journal of Parasitology since 2006. He is the 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President of World Federation of Parasitologists since 2010 and the Treasurer of International Federation for Tropical Medicine since 2012. Now he is serving as the President of ICOPA 2018.
