Dr. Petrus Tang is currently Professor of the Institute of Medical Sciences and Department of Parasitology, Chang Gung University in Taiwan. He is also the Head of the Chang Gung Bioinformatics Core Laboratory. Prof. Tang obtained his Master degree in Tropical Medicine from the National Defense Medical Center, Taiwan in 1986 and Ph.D. degree from the Department of Pathology, Cambridge University in 1995. Prof. Tang was elected as the present President of the Taiwan Society for Parasitology in 2016. Prof. Tang have been working on the biology and genomics of *Trichomonas vaginalis* for more than 20 years. He is one of the pioneers on studying miRNA gene regulatory network in protozoan. His major research interest is to use bioinformatics approaches to integrate data generated from multi-omics technologies to study parasite-host interaction and to develop visualization methods that makes computational biology accessible to research scientists with no programming experience.
