Dr. Matthias Marti is a Professor at the Wellcome Centre for Molecular Parasitology at the University of Glasgow, UK. He is a parasitologist with training in genetics, molecular and cell biology and 15 years of experience in malaria research. His work focuses on malaria transmission, specifically their formation and development in humans, animal models and in vitro. Further work focuses on natural transmission reducing immunity and its potential for novel transmission blocking interventions. Dr. Marti is involved in field collaborations in Malawi and Panama.

Dr. Marti received his PhD at the University of Zurich, Switzerland in 2003 and completed postdoctoral work at the Walter and Eliza Hall Institute in Melbourne, Australia in 2006. From 2007 to 2016 he was a faculty at the Harvard TH Chan School of Public Health in Boston, USA.
