Mingyuan Liu, is Professor at Jilin University, Dean of Veterinary Medicine College and Director of zoonosis institute in Changchun, PR China. He was awarded the Young Scientist Prize in China and coordinated more than 20 national and international research grants. He published 65 international papers. He is the contact Person of OIE Collaborating Centre for Food-Borne Parasites from the Asian-Pacific Region. The centre designated by OIE in 2014 was comprised of some of the top food-borne parasitologists in China, and has already built a strong linkage internationally, including with the existing OIE CC for Food-Borne Parasites in France and Canada for the OIE region of the America and EU. The mission of the Centre was to give scientific advice for controls and related education for national or regional needs. The Centre focuses its activities on implementation of international standardization methods, training for Asia-Pacific, and work collaboratively to develop new diagnostic methods and produce reference reagents, and also provide technology transfer, expert consultation, scientific and technical support to laboratories of food-borne Parasites like *Trichinella* spp., *Clonorchis sinensis*, *Cryptosporidium* spp., *Giardia duodenalis*, *Toxoplasma gondii*, *Echinococcus granulosus/multilocularis*, *Taenia solium/saginata* and so on in China and elsewhere in Asia-Pacific region or any member country of OIE requesting a support. Prof. Liu Mingyuan is Executive Committee Member of ICT (International Commission on Trichinellosis) and Executive Board Member (advisor) of WFP (World Federation of Parasitologists).
