



Dr. Hiroshi Yamasaki

Dr. Hiroshi Yamasaki is a senior researcher in the Department of Parasitology, National Institute of Infectious Diseases, Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, Japan. He received his PhD from Juntendo University School of Medicine, Tokyo, in 1990, and worked on fascioliosis and toxocariasis at the same university over 23 years. He moved to the Department of Parasitology, Asahikawa Medical University, Hokkaido, as an associate professor in April 2001 and worked on cestode zoonoses, and then moved to the current research institute in April 2007. His current research has focused on the development of rapid point-of-care test kits of parasitic zoonoses including larva migrans, fascioliosis and cysticercosis, and the molecular systematics and epidemiology of diphyllbothriid and taeniid tapeworms.
